EDINBURGH / GLASGOW / TROSSACHS / LOCH LOMOND / FORT WILLIAM / OBAN / ISLE OF SKYE / KYLE OF LOCHALSH / INVERNESS / LOCH NESS / ABERDEEN





DAY 1

Glasgow

Arrive in Edinburgh or Glasgow airport. Transfer to hotel in Glasgow. Panoramic tour of Glasgow with entrance to St. Mungo Cathedral. (depending on arrival time the visit of Glasgow and the cathedral can be done day 2). Dinner at leisure and overnight in hotel..

DAY 2

Trossachs / Loch Lomond - Fort William/Oban

Breakfast in hotel. Departure towards the western highlands along the shores of Loch Lomond, the largest lake in Scotland. Stop in Luss, charming village located on the shores of Loch Lomond. Continue to Inveraray and visit the amazing Castle, still now the home of the Dukes of Argyll. Continue to Fort William or Oban. Dinner and overnight in hotel.

DAY 3

Fort William/Oban – Isle of Skye/Kyle of Lochalsh – Inverness area

Breakfast in hotel. Stop at Neptune Staircase .Travel north west to Mallaig, with a stop at Glenfinnan monument to admire the gorgeous valley and stone railway bridge seen in the Harry Potter Movies. Embark the ferry for the Isle of Skye. Free time for lunch. Panoramic tour of Skye and stop by the mystic Eilean Donan Castle with his moat bridge and towers, also seen in the 80's movie Highlander. Dinner and overnight in hotel.

DAY 4

Inverness - Loch Ness - Inverness

Breakfast in hotel. Travel to Loch Ness and visit the majestic ruins of Urquhart Castle. Continue to Inverness and walk in the city, followed by free time for lunch in Inverness. In the afternoon, visit of a sheep farm and Sheep dog display. Continue to your hotel, dinner and overnight.



DAY 5

Inverness - Aberdeen

Breakfast in hotel. Departure to Elgin and visit its Cathedral. Continue through the Speyside, one of the most important regions for the production of Whisky, the national Scottish drink and its biggest export. Free time for lunch. Visit a whisky distillery, discover the secrets of its production and enjoy a tasting session. Continue to Aberdeen. Dinner and overnight in hotel.

DAY 6

Aberdeen - Edinburgh

Breakfast in hotel. Departure to Stonehaven and stop by Dunnottar Castle to take a picture and enjoy one of the most breathtaking views of the country: the castle ruins set on top of a high cliffs by the sea. Continue travel south and visit St.Andrews, lovely coastal town famous for its university and especially for being the home of golf. The Old Course is the most famous golf course in the world and in its club the rules of golf were written for the very first time. Fish & Chips Lunch. Visit Saint Andrew Cathedral .Arrive Edinburgh in the late afternoon. Overnight in hotel.

DAY 7

Edinburgh

Breakfast in hotel. Panoramic tour of Edinburgh, including the Old Town and the New Town, both UNESCO heritage sites thanks to their unique history and architecture. The tour will end with entrance to the impressive Edinburgh Castle, that dominates the city from a volcanic hill in the very centre of town. Free time for lunch. Visit of Palace of Holyroodhouse (can be replaced by Camera obsucra OR Georgian House). Overnight in hotel. Optional Scottish Evening at Prestonfield House or similar – includes 3 course dinner, haggis tasting, wine, 2 hours show with Scottish music and dance.

DAY8

Edinburgh - departure


Breakfast in hotel. Depart for Roslyn chapel (closed on Sunday morning for Mass service) Transfer to the airport and assistance to the check in.


Entrance fees included:
