DAY 1

Arrival in London

Arrival in London, transfer from London airport to the hotel and free time in the city. Accommodation.

DAY 2

London (AD)

Breakfast. In the morning we will make a panoramic tour of the city, starting with the West End of London, we will see Hyde Park, Piccadilly Circus and Trafalgar Square, residential and commercial areas, the Westminster neighborhood, passing through No. 10 Downing Street, residence of the Prime Minister, Parliament Square with the spectacular Westminster Abbey and the Palace of Westminster where the famous Big Ben is located. The tour ends in Covent Garden where we will have free time for lunch. Free afternoon to enjoy the city. Accommodation.

DAY 3

London - Stamford - York (AD)

After breakfast we will travel north, where we will stop in the small medieval city of Stamford, which was very important commercially thanks to its strategic position. Here we will have free time to have lunch and walk through its streets. We will continue our tour to the city of York, where we will visit its old town, famous for its medieval buildings and its splendid cathedral, the largest in northern Europe. Accommodation in the center of York..

DAY 4

York – Alnwick Castle - Edinburgh (AD)

Breakfast. Departure to the majestic Alnwick Castle. We will visit this spectacular building that has almost 1,000 years of history and has recently been the location of famous scenes from the Harry Potter movies and the Downton Abbey series. After this visit we will go to Edinburgh. Accommodation in the center of Edinburgh..

DAY 5

Edinburgh (AD)

Breakfast. In the morning we will visit this illustrious Scottish city, we will walk on the Royal Mile, known as the most important street in Edinburgh since it connects the Edinburgh Castle (admission included) and Holyrood Palace, official residence of the queen in Scotland. Afternoon free to walk in the old town and enjoy the atmosphere of this charming city.

DAY 6

Edinburgh - St. Andrews - Highlands (MP)

After breakfast we will depart for the north of Scotland. After crossing the spectacular Forth Bridge we will stop in the beautiful town of Falkland, used as Inverness in the 18th century to film the famous series Outlander. We will continue to St. Andrews, a charming medieval town famous for being the birthplace of golf and having the oldest university in the country. Afterwards, we will continue the route in the direction of Pitlochry to visit a Whiskey distillery with tasting included. Finally we will continue to the hotel in the Highlands. Dinner and accommodation.

DAY 7

Highlands - Loch Ness - Glasgow (MP)

Breakfast. We start the day visiting Loch Ness, the most famous lake in Scotland due to the legend of its resident monster "Nessie". We will take a boat trip on the lake from which you can admire the majestic landscapes of the highlands and the imposing ruins of Urquhart Castle. Then we will continue through Fort Augustus until we reach Fort William where we will have free time to eat and enjoy the place. We will continue to Glasgow where we will do a panoramic tour of the city. Arrival at the hotel, dinner and accommodation.

DAY 8

Glasgow - Ferry - Belfast (MP)

Breakfast. In the morning we will go to the port of Cairnryan where we will take the ferry to Belfast, the capital of Northern Ireland. We will make a panoramic tour of Belfast, a vibrant city with plenty of history and cultural interests. Its four large districts or 'quarters' (Cathedral, Titanic, Queen and Gaeltacht) are teeming with museums, pubs and art galleries. We will have free time with the option to enter the Titanic Museum, six floors that tell its history and construction, and the city of Belfast. Accommodation and dinner in the center of Belfast.

DAY 9

Belfast - Monasterboice – Athlone - Galway (MP)

Breakfast. In the morning we will go to Monasterboice to visit the ruins of an old monastery founded in the 5th century, of special relevance as a pilgrimage center. After a stop in the ancient town of Athlone, we will continue to Galway. Dinner and accommodation in hotel.

DAY 10

Galway - Burren - Cliffs of Moher - Limerick (MP)

Departure to the Burren region, a very particular geological formation, whose lunar and desert landscapes hide innumerable archaeological, botanical and zoological treasures. We will continue visiting the Cliffs of Moher where you can experience the thrill of walking on the most famous cliffs in Ireland. Crossing the spectacular coast of County Clare we will arrive at Limerick, located near the estuary of the River Shannon. Dinner and accommodation in hotel.

DAY 11

Limerick – Rock of Cashel - Kilkenny - Dublin (AD)

Breakfast. Visit the Rock of Cashel, also known as Saint Patrick's Rock, which was the main residence of the Kings of Munster from 370 to 1101. Continue to Kilkenny, where we will have free time to enjoy this charming medieval city. In the afternoon arrival in Dublin and hotel accommodation.

DAY 12

Dublin (AD)

Breakfast. We will take a panoramic view of the city passing through Dublin Castle, Phoenix Park, St. Patrick's Cathedral, Trinity College, the oldest university in Ireland, founded by Queen Elizabeth I in 1592 and home of the famous "Book of Kells". Free afternoon. Hotel accommodation.

DAY 13

Dublin - Ferry - Holyhead - Liverpool (AD)

Breakfast. We will go to the port of Dublin to take the ferry to Holyhead, located in Wales. We will be able to enjoy the beautiful landscape of this country, we will pass by Caernarfon Castle, where we will stop to take photos, before continuing east until we reach the famous city of Liverpool. We will make a panoramic visit and admire the city that saw the birth of The Beatles. Accommodation in the center of Liverpool.

DAY 14

Liverpool - Stratford-Upon-Avon - Oxford - London (AD)

After breakfast we will leave for Shakespeare's hometown, Stratford-Upon-Avon, we will walk through this small but charming town where we can take photos of the house where the famous writer, William Shakespeare was born. We will continue to London but before we will visit Oxford, known as the city of dreaming spires. Here is one of the most prestigious universities in the world, we will walk through its charming streets and we will pass through several of its university colleges. We continue to London. Accommodation.

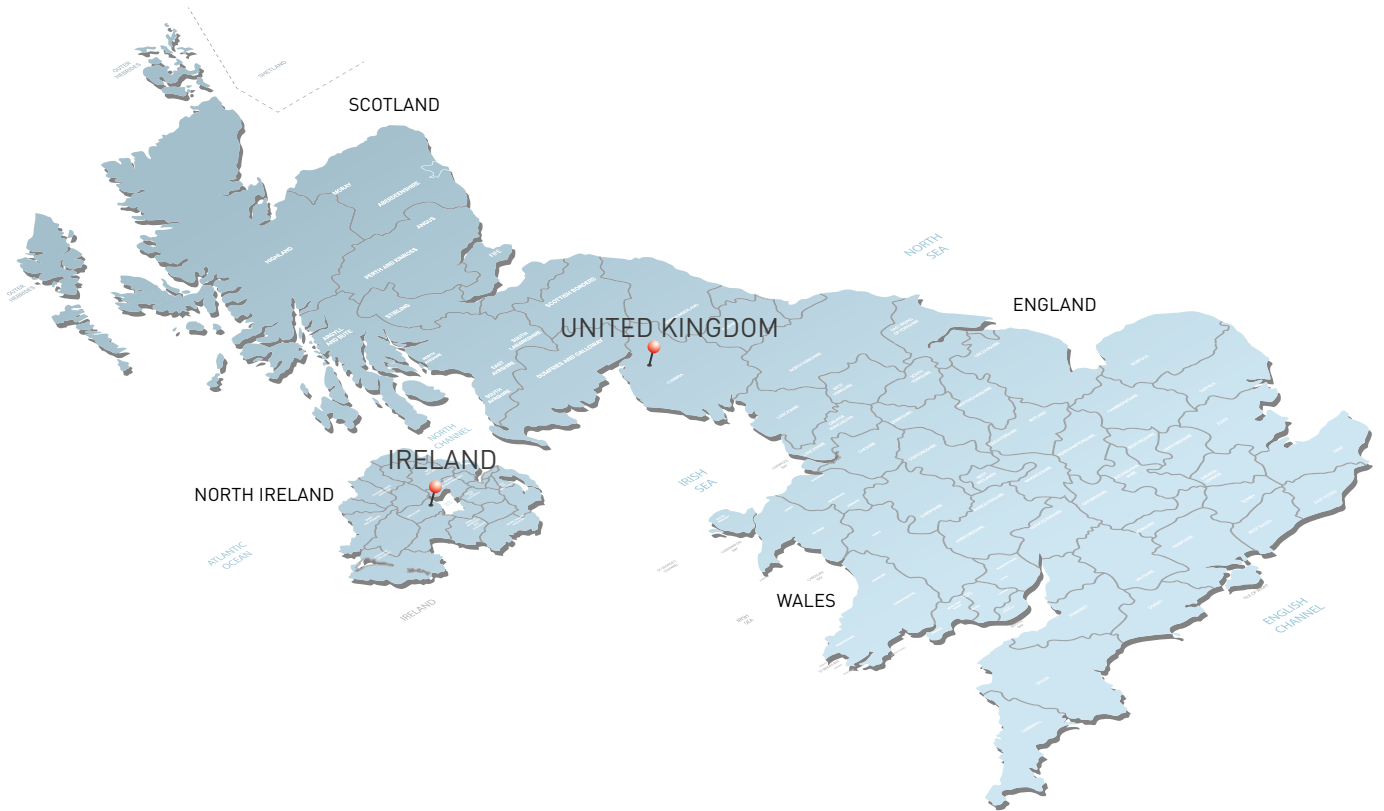
DAY 15

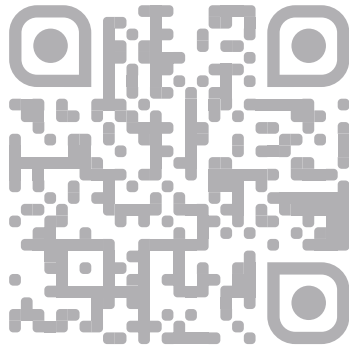
