DAY 1

Italy - Glasgow

Arrival and meeting with our escort/guide. Transfer to Glasgow. Dinner and overnight stay in hotel in Glasgow.

DAY 2

Glasgow - Stirling - West Highland Way - West Coast

Breakfast at the hotel. Panoramic tour of Glasgow and visit to St Mungo's Chair. Depart for Stirling, former capital of the Kingdom of Scotland and the stage for some of the most salient episodes in the country's history Free lunch. Visit Stirling Castle, where many of Scotland's monarchs, including Mary Stuart, were crowned. Continuation to the Highlands with a stop at Loch Lomond, Britain's largest lake. Continuation to the West Highland Way area. Dinner and overnight stay in a hotel.

DAY₃

West Coast - Isle of Skye/Kyle of Lochalsh - Inverness/Aviemore

Breakfast at the hotel and depart for Mallaig, through the Glencoe Valley, famous for its breathtaking scenery. Board the ferry with destination Isle of Skye. Free lunch. In the afternoon scenic tour of the island with pa essay near Eilean Donan Castle. Dinner and overnight stay in a hotel on the Isle of Skye or in the Inverness area depending on availability.

DAY 4

Inverness - Loch Ness - Inverness

Breakfast at the hotel, depart for Loch Ness and take a one-hour cruise on the waters of the mysterious lake, from where you can see the ruins of Urquhart Castle and try to catch a glimpse of Nessie, a legendary creature thought to have di- mitted here for about a century. Free lunch in Inverness. In the afternoon, visit Fort George. Dinner and overnight stay at a hotel in the Inverness area.



DAY 5

Inverness/Aviemore - Aberdeen

Breakfast and departure for Elgin with a visit to Elgin Cathedral. Pro- ceed for a tour with tasting of a Whisky distillery. Free lunch. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 6

Aberdeen - Edinburgh

Breakfast at the hotel. Depart for Stonehaven with photo stop at the ruins of Dunnottar Castle located on a breathtaking cliff overlooking the sea. Continuation to Dundee and arrival in Forfar. Visit Glamis Castle, official residence of the Earls Strathmore and Kinghorne and place where the Queen Mother, mother of the present queen, spent much of her youth, and free lunch. Afterwards, departure for Edinburgh. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 7

Edinburgh

Breakfast at the hotel and sightseeing tour of the city with a visit to **Edinburgh Castle**, a splendid stronghold overlooking the city from the top of its volcanic rock. Free lunch and afternoon at leisure. Free dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 8

Edinburgh - Italy

Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to Edinburgh or Glasgow airport. End of our services.


