## DAY 1

### Arrival to Belfast

### Banbridge

Your next stop is Banbridge in County Down. Here you will find the world's only official Game of Thrones Studio Tour. The Studio Tour is located at the original filming location of Linen Mills Studios. You'll get a behind-the-scenes look at Westeros and the production of one of the biggest TV series ever. Passionate fans and TV aficionados alike will be thrilled with the sets, original props, clothing and sets.

## DAY 4

### Cushendun

In the early morning travel to Cushendun, a picturesque coastal village, where you can explore the Cushendun Caves. These caves were featured in the series as the place where Melisandre gave birth to a shadow creature.

Enjoy the stunning views of the coast and the quaint charm of Cushendun

After that, head to the iconic Giant's Causeway, a UNESCO World Heritage site known for its unique basalt columns. This location was used to film the rugged landscapes of the Iron Islands.

Continue to Ballintoy, a small coastal village that served as the setting for Pyke, the Iron Islands' capital.

Explore Ballintoy Harbor and walk along the picturesque coastline, immersing yourself in the Game of Thrones atmosphere.

Finally, head to Ballymoney to visit the Dark Hedges. This enchanting avenue of beech trees served as the backdrop for the Kingsroad in Game of Thrones.

Take a leisurely walk along the Dark Hedges and capture some memorable photos.

Return to the hotel in the evening for dinner and overnight.

### Tollymore Forest Park

### Belfast - Departure

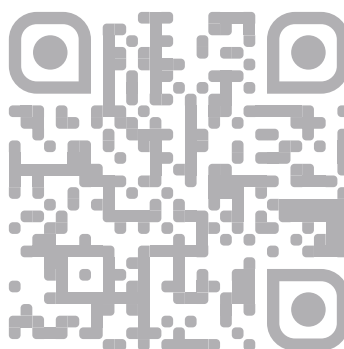
Enjoy a leisurely morning in Belfast, exploring any sites or attractions you may have missed during your stay.
